2023 PROPOSED INTERNATIONAL COUNCIL BYLAW CHANGES

READS

ARTICLE VI. – ELECTIONS

Section 2. Voting

Candidates shall be elected according to a preferential electronic voting system approved by the Executive Board by vote at the annual meeting. A ballot containing the names of the nominees shall be distributed via email before the date of the annual election. Nominations may be made from the floor for all offices with the exception of President. "Notice of Intent to Nominate" for all offices with the exception of President from the floor shall be submitted in writing to the First Vice President, 60 days prior to the election. Candidates so nominated must conform to provisions of Article V. Nominations for each office shall not exceed five. Voting shall begin after the close of the First General Assembly.

PROPOSED CHANGE

ARTICLE VI. – ELECTIONS

Section 2. Voting

Candidates shall be elected according to a preferential electronic voting system approved by the Executive Board by vote at the annual meeting. A slate of officers containing the names of the nominees shall be distributed to each member of International Council in good standing by February 28 and printed in the ESA Magazine. Nominations may be made from the floor for all offices with the exception of President. "Notice of Intent to Nominate" for all offices with the exception of President from the floor shall be submitted in writing to the First Vice President, 60 days prior to the election. Candidates so nominated must conform to provisions of Article V. Nominations for each office shall not exceed five.

RATIONAL

To comply with method of notification of membership of Slate of Officers Nominated.

Section 3. Election Determination

Elections shall be determined by plurality vote of delegates casting their own and proxy votes. In the event of a tie for the largest number of votes, there shall be a re-ballot for that office between the candidates receiving the votes.

Section 3. Election Determination

Elections shall be determined by plurality vote of delegates casting their own and proxy votes, processed by the determined electronic voting system. In the event of a tie for the largest number of votes, there shall be a re-vote for that office between the candidates receiving the votes.
